February is upon us and with it comes the birthday of one of my favorite founding fathers, Brother George Washington, who wrote in a letter to Alexander Hamilton on the 28th of August, 1788, a most striking statement, “Still I hope I shall always possess firmness and virtue enough to maintain (what I consider the most enviable of all titles) the character of an honest man.”

February also marks the birthday of another prominent thinker and political philosopher, President Abraham Lincoln, who wrote on July 1st, 1850, in Notes for a Law Lecture, “Resolve to be honest at all events; and if in your own judgment you cannot be an honest lawyer, resolve to be honest without being a lawyer.”
