St. Patrick’s Day – From Column 3

The day commemorates Saint Patrick and the arrival of Christianity in Ireland, and by extension, celebrates the heritage and culture of the Irish in general. Celebrations generally involve public parades and festivals, and wearing of green attire or shamrocks.

Christians who belong to liturgical denominations also attend church services, and historically the Lenten restrictions on eating and drinking alcohol were lifted for the day, which has encouraged and propagated the holiday’s tradition of alcohol consumption.

Saint Patrick’s Day is a public holiday in the Republic of Ireland, United Kingdom, Canada, United States, Australia, South Africa, New Zealand, and other countries. Saint Patrick’s Day is celebrated in more countries than any other national festival.
